

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR) INFORMATION AND CONSENT



Aiming the compliance of the BRILAKIS ORTHOPAEDICS IKE (Private Medical Company) and his founder and Director, EMMANOUIL BRILAKIS, MD, MSc, PhD, Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgeon, with the New General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union (679/2016/EU) as well as the Greek legislation about data protection (Law No. 4624/2019), we would like to inform you that this company archives and processes the personal data of the patients in order to provide the required medical services towards them.

Aims of Processing Personal Data

- For the development and the application of appropriate medical methods, diagnostic techniques and treatments.
- For scheduling and performing orthopaedic surgeries according the therapeutic needs of each patient.
- For the communication with the patients in terms of providing the optimal medical services to them (i.e. to schedule appointments or/and surgeries, to inform for results etc.).
- For the prescription of the appropriate pharmaceutical treatment.
- For research scopes and for scientific studies that will be submitted for publishing in peer reviewed scientific journals and/or they will be presented in scientific conferences. In those cases, the patients will be informed and asked for specific consent and their data will be presented ensuring the proper depersonalization.
- For the compliance of the Company with the legal obligations that derive from the medical, tax or other legislation.

Description of Personal Data Collected

The personal data collected for each patient from the Company, according the aforementioned aims are the following: Patient's full name, father's name, gender, date of birth, contact information (telephone number, e-mail address, postal address, National social security numbers (AMKA, AMA), social and private insurances, profession, medical record (family and prescription of tests and pharmaceutical treatment, medical record data (medical history, patient's family medical history, anthropometric data, diagnostic data, recommended treatment and management, pharmaceutical protocols, clinical and laboratory data, surgeries and every other useful data for the proper management).

Time Period of Personal Data Keeping

The Company keeps your personal data for a period of ten (10) years, complied with the relative legislative orders and the Code of Medical Ethics (article 14 of Law No. 3418/2005).

Security of Personal Data – Data Transfer to Third Parties

The Company as well as Dr. Emmanouil Brilakis, MD, MSc, PhD, follow the Code of Medical Ethics, securing the confidentiality of your medical data and ensuring the protection of them. All necessary technical and organizational security measurement have been taken care by the Company in order to protect your data. Special care for regular inspection and check of those measurements has been taken. No one else than Dr. Emmanouil Brilakis and his partners, after his indication, have access to your data and nothing is transmitted, transferred or forwarded to third party.

Patient's Rights Concerning Personal Data

According to GDPR, you have the following rights concerning your personal data that the Company preserves for you, whenever it is applicable: **the right to be informed, the right of access, the right to rectification, the right to erasure/to be forgotten, the right to restrict processing, the right to data portability, the right to object and the right of denouncement** according the Principles of the Hellenic Data Protection Authority (www.dpa.gr).
